Educators are eligible to apply for **Title II-Teacher Quality program funds of No Child Left Behind** by contacting **their school district science/curriculum administrator** to attend Science Olympiad Summer Institutes designed for Teachers, Coaches, Supervisors and Administrators grades 6-12. Classes will cover most or all of the 46 events such as Junkyard Challenge, Electric Vehicle, Tower Building, Road Scholar, Experimental Design, Remote Sensing, Robots, Fossils, Earthquakes and Volcanoes, Environmental Chemistry, Chem. Lab, Disease Detective, Wright Stuff, Forensics, Bottle Rockets and more plus New Events for next year. Also learn how to build a team and gain support for your science program. The registration includes the course fee, room and board, all instruction, rules manual, changes for next year, classroom materials and activities that will help you compete and meet your state's core curriculum science benchmarks and standards. Room and board (housing fee) is in addition to the registration fee. Commuters must pay registration, equipment, facility and meals fee. *Many Science Olympiad coaches at State & National finals attribute their success to concepts learned at the SO Summer Institutes. Over 98% rate the institutes as good or excellent and say that their batteries are recharged, that they learn so much and are glad to be with other educators that are passionate about learning science!*

The Hilton Conference Center, Arizona is situated on the top of Tapatio Cliffs overlooking Phoenix, occupying 105 secluded acres of beautifully landscaped desert.
